Definition of the Church: The church is a united (John 17:20-23), set-apart (Col. 3:12), universal (Eph. 4:1-6), and biblically based (Eph. 2:20) New Covenant community made up of all believers between the time of <u>Pentecost</u> (Acts 2) and the <u>rapture</u> (1 Thess. 4:13-5:11).

The word *rapture* derives from the Latin *rapere* meaning "to snatch" and translates the Greek word *harpazo* in 1 Thess. 4:17. The rapture describes Christ's coming for his church, both dead and alive, who will experience a bodily resurrection and be transformed from mortal to immortal (1 Cor. 15:51-52).
